Pupil Mobile Phone Permission Form

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our school policy, mobile phones are not allowed to be used during school hours. However, we understand that some parents may want their child to have a mobile phone for safety reasons while walking to and from school. If you wish for your child to bring a mobile phone, please complete the form below. By signing this form, you are giving your consent for your child to bring their mobile phone to school under the conditions outlined below.

Conditions:

1. Mobile phones must not be used during school hours for any purpose.
2. All pupils are required to hand in their mobile phones to the designated staff member at the start of the school day. Phones will be securely stored and can be collected at the end of the school day.
3. The mobile phone may only be used for communication purposes while travelling to and from school.
4. The school is not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to the mobile phone. It is your child's responsibility to ensure their phone is securely handed in at the start of the school day.
5. If your child is found using their phone during school hours without permission, the phone may be confiscated and appropriate consequences given.
